

Board of Selectmen
Minutes September 24, 2013

Convened at 6:00 pm

The Board met and reviewed payroll, accounts payable and signed the register. The Selectmen reviewed and signed the recreation register.

Overtime for this pay period is 0.5 hours police and 4 hours fire department.

Jonathan Ellis was in to present the weekly Treasurer's report. Please see last page to view report.

Building Inspector Gil Tuck had the following building permits to be signed:

Christiansen made a motion, 2nd by Byrne to approve the public minutes of 09/17/2013. Artimovich, Byrne, Bryan, and Christiansen were in favor. Menter abstained as he was not present.

Bryan made a motion, 2nd by Byrne to approve the nonpublic minutes of 09/10/2013. All were in favor.

Nick Cricenti from SFC Engineering will be processing driveway permit applications on an interim basis.

The flu clinic will be October 8th from 9:30 to 10:00am at the town office.

The Pine Road trial is scheduled for October 22-24. Counsel does not anticipate the trial lasting 3 days.

Bryan inspected a leak at the BRC and recommends getting the chimney repaired. Clement will call masons to get a couple estimates for the board to review.

Ron Grandmaison from NHDOT was present to discuss rumble strips on Rte. 125. The department is looking to put in center line and shoulder rumble strips along Rte. 125 from Rochester to Plaistow to reduce fatalities from crossing over the yellow line into oncoming traffic. The rumble strips will be 12" under the double yellow line; the DOT will also evaluate the safety of all passing lanes. The shoulder rumble strips will be alternating a 48" strip of rumble with a 12" gap. No strips will be placed in areas where the shoulder is less than 48" wide to allow for bicycles to travel safely. The 12" gaps between the strips will allow for bicycles to cross lanes of traffic safely. The shoulder rumbles will increase reflectivity especially during inclement weather and times of solar glare. This project is 90% federal and 10% state funded. Chief Robinson said he was in support of this project. Byrne made a motion, 2nd by Christiansen to accept with gratitude the implementation of center line and shoulder rumble strips along Rte. 125 in Brentwood. All were in favor.

Artimovich asked if the speed on Rte. 125 south of South Road could be evaluated. Grandmaison said he would look into it as the reduction in speed would need to be supported with data from a speed study.

The board reviewed the MS1 and Christiansen made a motion, 2nd by Bryan to submit the 2013 MS1 to NHDRA. All were in favor.

A letter was signed by the board to the property owners of 166 Pickpocket Road granting permission to remove a tree on a scenic road as discussed last week.

Clement said Sancoucy's office had estimated \$3000 for work on the NHEC and Fairpoint utility appeals. To date the fees have been closer to \$6000. Clement is working with Sancoucy's office to get an estimate of costs for the remainder of the year.

Robinson said the new cruiser is over at Adamson's and should be on the road within the next 4 weeks.

A resident was in to discuss speed and safety issues on Bartlett and Dudley Road. Robinson said he is aware of the activity and it usually takes place at night when there is only 1 cruiser on patrol. Artimovich suggested the resident call 911 as soon as he is aware the activity is taking place and asked that the officer on duty increase patrols in that area.

Motion to adjourn at 6:46 pm made by Bryan, 2nd by Christiansen; all were in favor.
